  - THRIVE Practitioner
  - Therapeutic Education Assistant
- A Family Support Worker
- A committed teaching team across three phases: Lower School, Upper School and Sixth Form
- Higher Level Teaching Assistants trained to provide curriculum based interventions.

### How we support students...

- Regular liaison between our onsite multidisciplinary team and education team to ensure an integrated approach between therapy and education.
- Tailored supportive strategies embedded into everyday school life to promote wellbeing and learning.
- Sensory friendly environments catering to individual needs across the school, including small class sizes, a sensory garden, sensory room & individual learning pods.
- A variety of whole school and individual rewards to acknowledge the achievements of our students.
- Regular opportunities available to develop a range of skills, including gardening, school council, yoga, and regular offsite school trips.

### How we support families...

- Frequent communication between home and school via regular telephone calls, emails or classdojo.
- A dedicated Family Support Worker to liaise with families when needed.
- Regular academic and clinical reports sent home to share progress within school
- Strong links with the local community. including the local police force, parish council and university.
