Description of event: Throughout the Spring 2 term at Wisbech School, all pupils at Anglia Way and Sessions House came together to raise funds for Nelson's Journey charity. This charity supports young people who are going through or are suffering from loss and bereavement. In order for our pupils to spread awareness of this organisation, activities were chosen and posters were made to resemble how they were going to fundraise their own sponsors to support this charity. Activities such as litter picking, long distance walks and a bake sale were of great interest. Pupils took responsibility in organising these activities and ensuring they spread the most awareness possible.

All monies raised by pupils were accumulated at the end of term and an astonishing amount was raised. Our Smarties class raised £101.92 for dressing up as their favourite book characters, including Harry Potter and the Wimpy Kid whilst walking/running around the local park. In addition, two Anglia Way pupils organised a delicious bake sale, raising £101.12. Overall, as a team, Wisbech School have raised a total amount of £462.49 for Nelson's Journey.
