

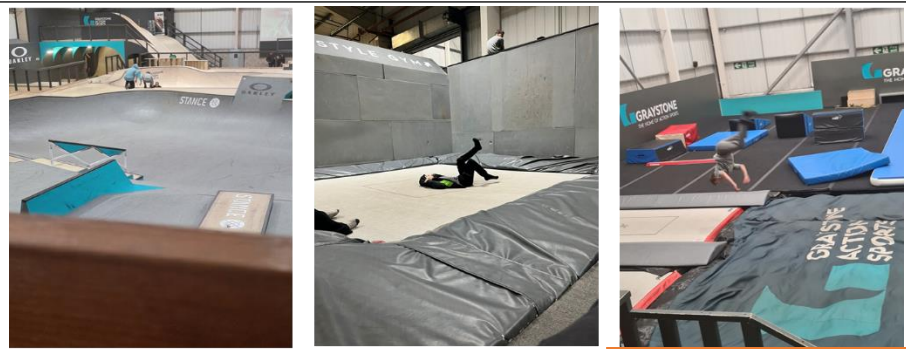


This Week:

Our students expressed good community skills by assisting an injured visitor at Greystone



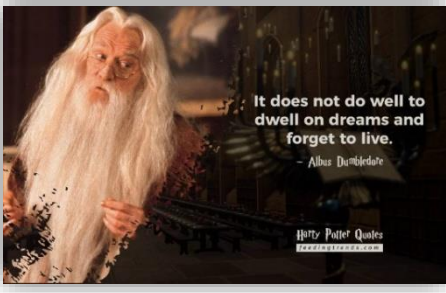
This week students have been enjoying the new staff member Daisy the therapy dog being around the school. In terms of curriculum students have been learning various subject objectives such as:

- Geography: Urbanisation

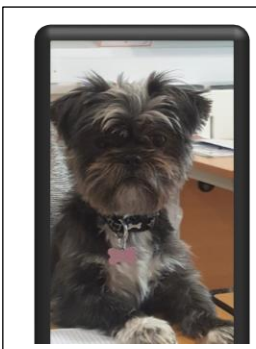
