

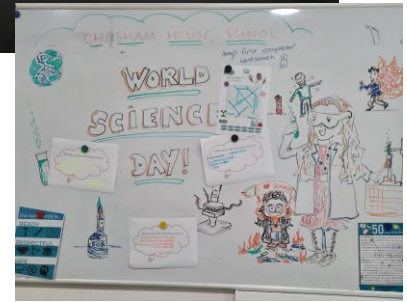
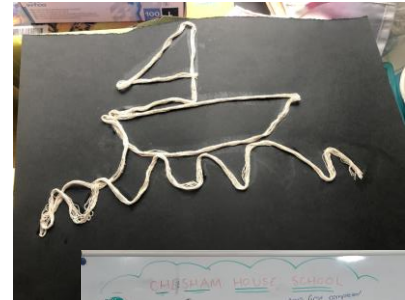


REMEMBRANCE DAY
