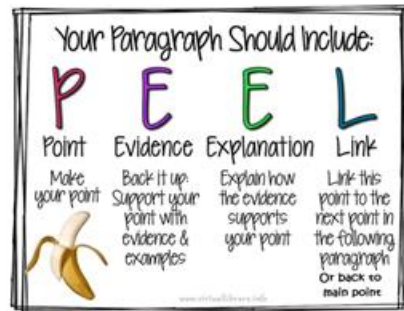


This Week:

- This week in Science, students have been learning about microorganisms and rates of reaction. On experiment Friday, students used concentration rates to investigate the impact of this on reaction rates.
- In English, functional skills students have been learning about similes and metaphors. We've been listening to songs and considering the lyrics and the similes and metaphors within them. In GCSE, they have learnt how to analyse language for effect and have learnt how to write effective PEEL paragraphs. They have also compared different texts and written summaries for each one that they have studied.
- In Art, students have been creating graffiti street art inspired by artists such as Banksy.
