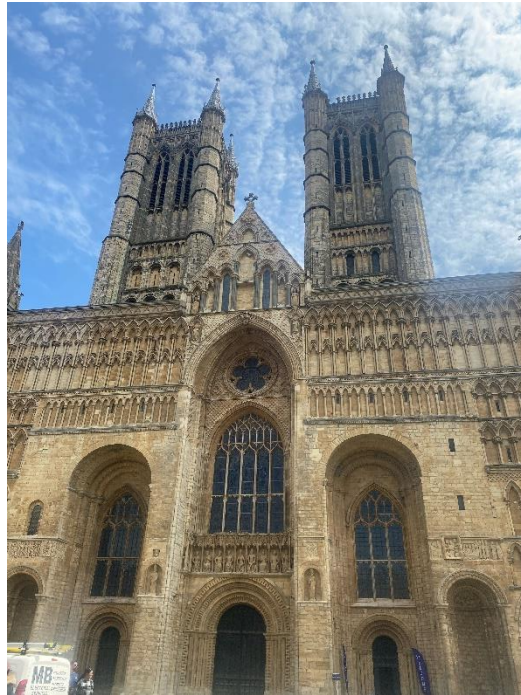


Outcomes:

- To learn about the history of Lincoln Castle
- To explore the Castle Prison
- To learn about the Magna Carta
- To visit Lincoln Cathedral



Description of trip:

Groups D, E and F all completed visits to Lincoln Castle over the summer terms. During our visits we explored the old prison, which is situated within the walls of the castle and the Magna Carta. The most exciting part of all, for most, was the walk along the top of the castle walls and up to the tower, of which you could see the whole of Lincoln and in the sunshine, this was spectacular however, I wouldn't recommend this to anyone afraid of heights!!
