Description of the week:

This week students took part in our American culture day on Wednesday which involved activities and food tasting based on American culture and traditions. Some topics explored International Women's Day which was first celebrated in 1911!

Students have been covering algebra and percentages in maths, various science experiments in science such as making lava lamps and during English lessons students are focusing on the book Skellig, creating their reading journals based on this topic.
