Duke of Edinburgh Bronze expedition

This term, students will undertake their DofE bronze expedition. This is a 6hr walk a day, for two days with one night camping. Day 1 will be a walk from March to Denver, and day 2 will be a walk from The Lincolnshire main drain to Wisbech



The students helped plan the locations for the walk, and even looked at appropriate campsites for us. After the students complete this, they will gain their Duke of Edinburgh bronze award, which is equivalent to two grade 3 GCSE's.
