Summer Term has had many SMSC events taking place at Chesham. Throughout our learners have been gaining knowledge and skills about key values to take with them in life.

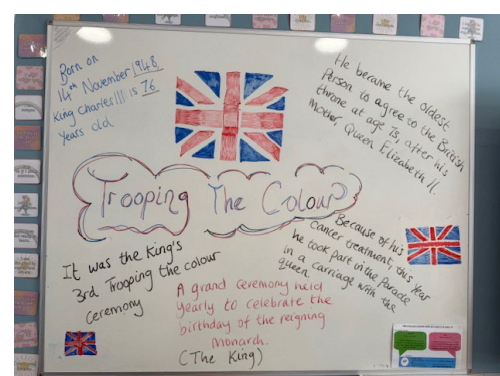

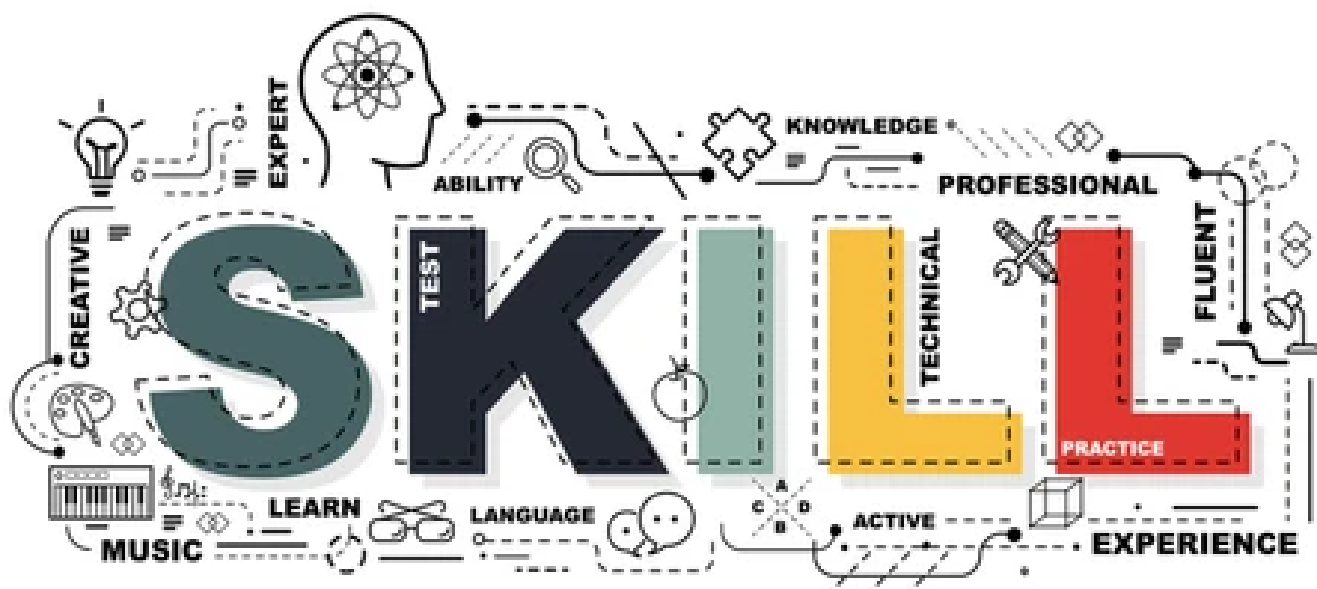
Pride 2025 – Within lessons learners discussed the importance of difference and equality in relation to Pride and respecting others no matter their own personal identity.
