We are proud to announce that, after a lot of hard work, the sensory room has now been completed, and we now have a brand-new sensory room for our residents to use. Our sensory room is now fully equipped with a wide variety of sensory devices, including an LED tube, colour changing fibre optics, fibre optics starlight wall, tactile sensory wall, music vibration chair, infinity mirror, and a wide variety of sensory toys, to name a few.



Since it has been completed, our residents at Shap Road have really enjoyed going into the sensory room and trying out all the new sensory devices and sensory toys. Their enjoyment of this new feature at Shap Road has made all of us feel proud of the hard work that has gone into it, as this is a big and important achievement that will play a big role in facilitating meeting our residents' mental wellbeing, learning and sensory needs.

Walk Along The River


As the weather was nice Sam, went for a walk into Kendal along the river. On the way, Sam stopped for a few minutes on the bridge to look at the river.

At More Music in Morecambe, Fern and Jon enjoyed modelling in clay.












Enjoying the Weather
