CAREERS INTERVIEWS

THE AIM OF THESE SESSIONS IS TO HELP OUR YOUNG PEOPLE CONSIDER CAREER AND STUDY OPTIONS FOR THE FUTURE. THESE ARE HALF HOUR SESSIONS AND WILL TAKE PLACE ON 14TH, 21ST AND 28TH NOVEMBER THROUGHOUT THE DAY – ALL STUDENTS WILL HAVE A TIMETABLED SLOT. STUDENTS CAN ATTEND EITHER INDEPENDENTLY OR WITH A MEMBER OF SCHOOL STAFF IF THEY FEEL MORE COMFORTABLE. STUDENTS WILL PREPARE FOR THESE INTERVIEWS WHEN THEY RETURN TO SCHOOL AFTER HALF TERM, AND IN PREPARATION FOR THIS, CAN YOU PLEASE TAKE THE OPPORTUNITY TO HAVE SOME DISCUSSIONS AROUND NEXT STEPS AND CAREERS AT HOME WITH YOUR SON/DAUGHTER. FOLLOWING THE INTERVIEWS INDIVIDUAL REPORTS WILL BE PRODUCED AND THESE WILL BE SHARED WITH THE STUDENTS.


