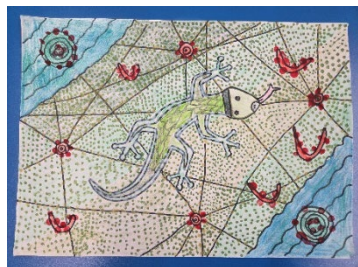


Curious About Culture!
