

PROCEDURES FOR REPORTING YOUR CHILD'S ABSENCE FROM SCHOOL

Parents must ring the school office by 8.30 am or leave a message to report the reason for your child's absence

Attendance Office will ring first contact to try and ascertain why your child is absent from school

CONTACT MADE

No further action

NO CONTACT

Attendance Office will ring for a second time so you can advise us of the reason you're your child's absence

CONTACT MADE

Attendance Office will ring once more so you can advise us of the reason for your child's absence

CONTACT MADE

NO CONTACT

If we have not received a response regarding your child's absence and we are concerned about your child's welfare, we may send a member of staff to make a home visit. If there is no answer a compliment slip will be posted through the door asking you to make urgent contact with the school office
