Our school is equipped to deal with the needs of a variety of students with a range of abilities both academically and with communication. We focus on communication and social skills, with a strong emphasis on self-management and independence.

All of our children can have access to SMARTBOX AAC devices to help them to communicate and have more independence. Staff are provided with device training and support and ongoing clinical support where needed to make sure the people received devices are supported throughout their journey AAC. We can measure the impact of AAC and how it affects people's behaviours, their individual goals and the team supporting them.
