Young people who attend these schools all have a clear primary presenting need and will have associated complex needs. Our Schools have a proven track record of academic, social and emotional development.

Our highly dedicated, highly skilled and experienced team of teaching, care and health

professionals focus on providing a tailored environment and individualised programmes of learning, where we aim to draw out the potential in each student and work alongside them to discover their strengths and maximise their full potential. A key objective for each placement is to successfully prepare each student for adult life.

Our Post 16 Specialist Colleges

Cambian has a heritage of providing outstanding education and care for learners aged 16 to 25 with Autism, Asperger's, moderate to severe learning disabilities and complex needs. Students attending our Colleges may well have previously attended a specialist school, or have been supported in a mainstream setting with an EHCP where it is clear additional learning will be key for their adult life.

Our highly dedicated, highly skilled and experienced team of teaching, care and health professionals focus on providing a tailored environment and individualised learning programmes matching their needs, choices and aspirations; be the focus on daily living skills, vocational qualifications or independent living and transition into adult life.

Residential Care Services

SEMH & Complex Needs

Our Solo (Single bed), Dual (Two beds) and Group Homes (Three to Six Beds) provide care for young people aged 6 to 18 years old. Our homes are designed to meet the needs and manage the risks of some of the UK's most complex and challenging young people.

We have staffing ratios of 2:1 in our Solo Homes, 1:1 in our Dual Homes and high ratios across our Group Homes. These homes support a pathway for young people who will remain in residential care and where possible return to a family environment. We have a number of SEMH Schools that are able to support the continuity of education.

CSE

Supporting girls aged between 11 & 17 years old who are victims of sexual exploitation. Trauma may be represented in challenging behaviours, attachment disorder, lack of emotional stability, low sense of safety and security, sexual disinhibition and a history of placement breakdown.

Many of the young people that we support will be planned step down placements from a secure service. We have a clear model of care that includes care, therapy and education with an anticipated length of stay of 9 – 12 months.

Our expected outcomes would result in a young person safely returning to a family setting.

Complex Trauma

For children typically aged between suffered trauma as a result of: sexual abuse, neglect, domestic violence, physical harm and bereavement. These children may also show signs of inappropriate/problematic sexual behaviours such as; lack of understanding of appropriate touch, lack of understanding of healthy relationships with adults and peers and lack of understanding of consent. Our service operates a clear model an expected length of stay of 18 to 24 months. Children coming into this service have typically experienced placement (fostering) breakdowns.

Learning Disabilities & Deaf & Hearing Loss Support

We provide specialist support across these services for children and adults. Whilst having a primary need of a learning disability or hearing loss, all residents will have other associated complex needs.

We have high staffing ratios and in our Deaf services communicate in BSL.

Mental Health Services

Caring for young people that present with a primary mental health need, with other associated needs. Our service is a 'step-down' service for young people who are currently receiving a service from CAMHS.

Our Fostering Services





We are By the Bridge with Cambian. We are Fostering.

For us, children being at the heart of everything we do is no merely a statement, but the very foundations on which our organisation is built.

Foster parents are a vital component of our care model; a child could be affected by a trauma well into their adulthood if they do not receive the right help. Once a child is suitably matched and placed with a By the Bridge family, we continue to do everything we possibly can to work with the family to heal the trauma of abuse, neglect, loss or rejection a child may have experienced.

Therapeutic fostering isn't about becoming a therapist; it is a way of parenting a child who may have missed out on emotional development and milestones in their early

years. We understand that traumatised children may require a lot of help and encouragement to continue to develop the positive self-esteem and confidence they need to do well in life. We have many truly exceptional families at By the Bridge who do this impressive work every day.

Through our ongoing training and support we enable our Foster Parents to nurture and develop a child to achieve their personal best. We teach our Foster Parents to not only see a child's behaviour, but to understand it and enable them to respond in a therapeutic way. A Foster Parent can then understand why a child behaves in a certain way – even if the child does not yet fully understand it themselves. This keeps our placement breakdown rates low.

The end results speak for themselves, with children leaving our care as young adults with qualifications, confidence and the foundations on which to build their future.

By the Bridge have offices in the North West, Eastern, Midlands, Thames Valley and South East regions. We also have communities of foster families in the South and Sussex regions. We are able to offer a range of fostering placement categories which could be short or long term placements which can last from just a few days to several months or years (as required).
