Description of the week: All young people and staff returned to school this week and it was great to catch up with everyone who was remote working/learning. This week also saw us celebrate International Women's Day which was on the 8<sup>th</sup> March. This linked in nicely with our Cultural Day which was on the 10<sup>th</sup> March. The young people learned about the History of the USA, cuisine, for art creating a massive burger, culture of the USA and influential women of America. The Puffins class in maths have been working on decimals, looking at tenths and hundredths and seeing the connection with fractions. In literacy they have looked at non-chronological reports – ready to start planning their own. In history they have become historians studying and figuring out what certain Ancient Egyptian artefacts were used for. In science they finished their work on food groups and started looking at healthy eating. The Smarties class have begun planning and writing their non-chronological reports about Ancient Egypt. The children looked at examples before deciding on what they wanted to include and began planning out their writing. They then completed some research before starting their writing. In maths, they have been working on our knowledge of decimals and negative numbers, they then recapped rounding numbers. In Humanities, they have been acting like archaeologists and historians, working out what different artefacts from Ancient Egypt are and what they were used for. The class were quite shocked by some of the true answers! Due to the high winds the Forest School was cancelled on Thursday instead they took a trip along the Norfolk Coast, looking at the different beaches and the wind impact upon them.



