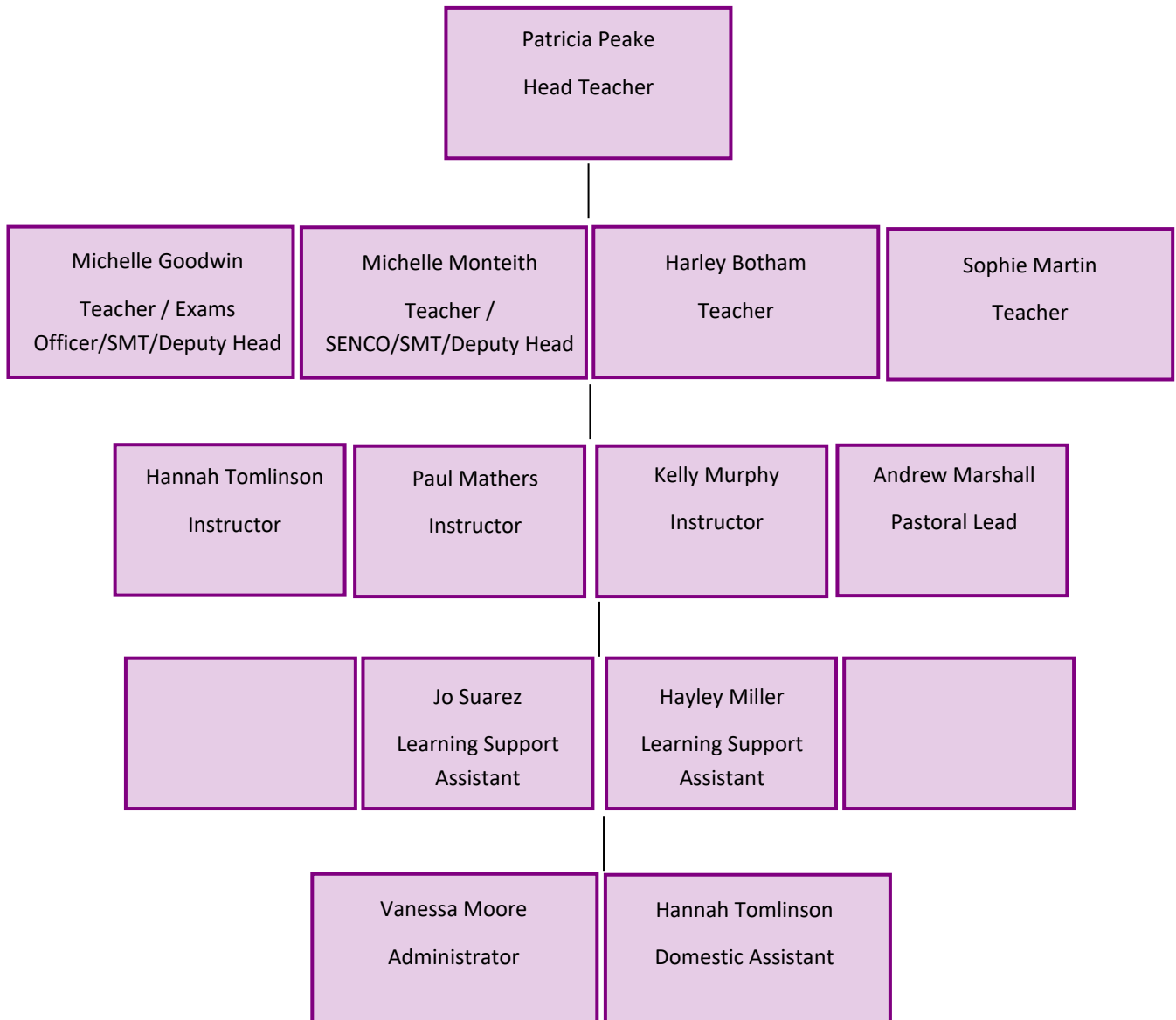


# Scarborough School



## Staffing

**Patricia Peake - Head Teacher.** Tricia has worked for the Scarborough School for over 17 years; as a Teacher, Deputy Head and now as Head. Previously she worked as a Residential Housemother for 10 years working for NCH both in Leeds and Scarborough and has also been self-employed owning her own business for 10 years. Tricia wanted to work in the education sector with SEN children; she worked as a Specialist Teaching Assistant at a local Primary school for six years and completed a 3 year degree course in BA (Hons) Professional studies in Primary Education. Qualifications include: BA (Hons) Professional Studies in Primary Education with English Literature, STA - Specialist Teaching Assistant, Level 4 Management Award.

**Michelle Monteith – Teacher, SENCO, Deputy Head.** Michelle studied at Lincoln University to complete her BSc (Hons) in Forensic Science and Psychology. After gaining experience working in schools as an Advanced Teaching Assistant she returned to University to complete a PGCE in Secondary Science.
