Internal Experience of Work

The curriculum is sequenced to develop a range of employability skills, in order to support students with on site work experience to replicate real-world work environments and to support with the embedding of work routines, following instructions, and following tasks through to completion to progress onto external work experience placements within their chosen vocational areas.

Assessment

By setting goals and evaluating progress through Skills for working Life and Personal Progress qualifications. Progress will be reviewed on a monthly and termly basis, with evidence collated as part of Student Journeys to inform any changes to each students' learning plan

Experiences of the Workplace

Participation in external work experience placements, and/or volunteering opportunities in the community.

By the end of their placement, students will have successfully demonstrated skills required for the world of work in a variety of contexts and will have had the opportunity to reflect their achievements within a vocational profile and CV to inform future transitions.

Destinations

Each student will complete a Vocational and Employability Profile to collate their future destinations and preferred activities in order to create a plan for developing their employability skills in line with their aspirations and next steps.
