

Wisbech School Outcomes 2023

SUCCESSES

- In total 84 accredited qualifications have been achieved this year.
- Pupils, on average, have achieved 10.5 accredited qualifications.
- 100% of leavers at the end of Year 11 have secured places in further education.
 - 75% of pupils left Wisbech School with 5 GCSEs.
 - 5 pupils left with 10 or more accredited qualifications.
 - Two thirds of pupils left with at least 8 accredited qualifications.

PERSONAL ACHIEVEMENTS

Pupil A joined at the end of year 10 and achieved 6 GCSEs and 5 other accredited qualifications.

Pupil B joined at the start of year 11 and achieved 3 GCSEs and 2 other accredited qualifications.

Pupil C suffered the bereavement of a parent in year 10 and then went on to be diagnosed with kidney disease. He spent a significant amount of time in hospital but still achieved 6 GCSEs and 8 additional accredited qualifications.

Pupil D joined in January of year 11 and completed 4 GCSEs exams.

Pupil E had been a school refuser for years and went on to achieve 5 GCSEs and 5 additional accredited qualifications.

Pupil F achieved 6 GCSEs and 9 additional accredited qualifications and returned after his exams to support younger pupils in school.

Pupil H suffered a significant injury during year 10 which really knocked his confidence and meant he could not attend school regularly. He still went on to achieve 3 accredited qualifications and has a place on a college course for year 12.

LOOKING TO THE FUTURE

Pupil A has recently moved in to semi-independent living accommodation and has secured a place at college to study Health and Social Care.

Pupil B has secured himself a place in further education to continue his studies in maths and English. His ambition is to improve his confidence in these subjects to enable him to attend college to study animal care.

Pupil C has achieved results that have secured a place on a college course studying Childcare Studies.

Pupil E will be attending college to study Construction while continuing his studies in maths and English.

Pupil F has achieved results that have secured him a place at a local college studying Mechanics.

Pupil I will be attending a local college to study a course in Construction.
