Y11 - WORDESTER RADECOURSE TRIP

ON MONDAY 15TH SEPTEMBER, OUR YEAR 11 STUDENTS TOOK PART IN AN EXCITING "MATHS IN REAL LIFE" ENRICHMENT AND CAREERS TRIP TO WORCESTER RACECOURSE, HOSTED BY RACING TO SCHOOL.

THE GROUP WERE TREATED TO VIP ACCESS BEHIND THE SCENES, EXPLORING AREAS NOT USUALLY OPEN TO THE PUBLIC. IN THE JOCKEY WEIGHING ROOM, THEY DISCOVERED HOW METRIC AND IMPERIAL SYSTEMS ARE USED, PRACTICED CONVERTING AND ESTIMATING WEIGHTS, AND LEARNED HOW THE RACING HANDICAP SYSTEM WORKS. STUDENTS ALSO GOT UP CLOSE TO THE STEEPLECHASE FENCES, DISCUSSED RACE DISTANCES, AND WATCHED THE HORSES PREPARE TO ENTER THE TRACK.

IN THE AFTERNOON, STUDENTS WATCHED LIVE RACES. THEY EVEN PUT THEIR PROBABILITY SKILLS TO THE TEST BY TRYING TO PREDICT THE WINNERS! TO FINISH THE DAY, MOST OF THE GROUP JOINED THE CROWD IN THE STANDS TO EXPERIENCE THE THRILL OF THE FINAL RACE ALONGSIDE THE GENERAL PUBLIC.

IT WAS A FANTASTIC DAY FULL OF LEARNING, NEW EXPERIENCES, AND PLENTY OF EXCITEMENT- SHOWING JUST HOW POWERFUL MATHS CAN BE BEYOND THE CLASSROOM.




