Great results for Potterspurty Lodge School, both academically and socially once again in 2025!!

Many of our students met or exceeded their target grades. One student had target grades of 4s for English language and literature and achieved a 6 and an 8. Another student overcame their anxiety and sat all of their exams and achieved both a GCSE in Maths and Entry Level qualifications.

Another student, who in Y10 had an attendance of 21%, improved their attendance to 52%.

While we aspire for all of our students to achieve and surpass their target grades, we believe that education and the work we do here at Potterspurty is about so much more. It encompasses the development of self-esteem, confidence, independence and readiness for adult life. We are proud to have played a role in shaping these young people, and to have supported them on their journey of growth and discovery.
