On Wednesday, our class visited the March skate park and nearby park. The children had a wonderful morning exploring the outdoor space and participating in a variety of activities.

Children who brought scooters enjoyed riding them at the skate park and along the park pathways, practicing their balance, coordination, and physical confidence as they move through different obstacles. Those who did not have scooters spent time in the playground, where they explored the climbing gym and other play areas, developing their gross motor skills, strength, and problem-solving abilities.

One of the loveliest moments of the trip was seeing the children demonstrate kindness, cooperation, and sharing. A child who had scooted kindly offered in to a peer who wanted to ride. While waiting their turn, children showed patience and self-regulation, often running alongside.
