- Teamwork.



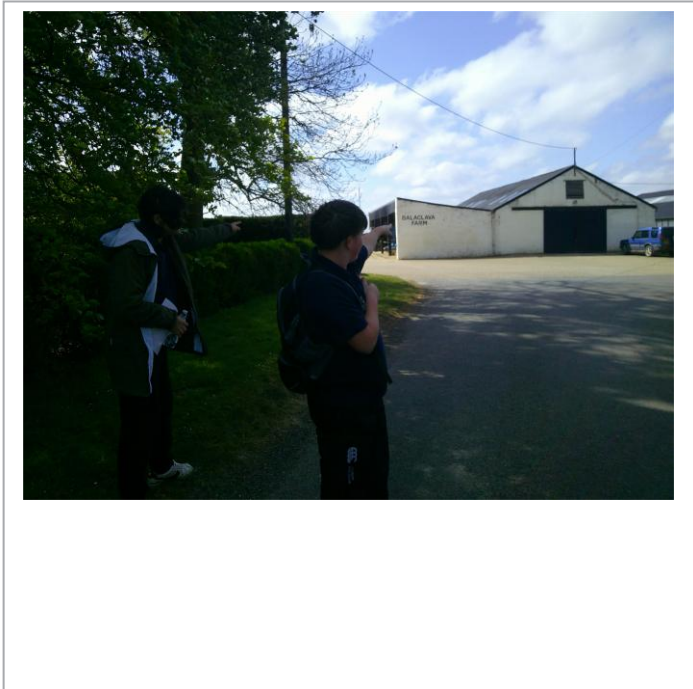
