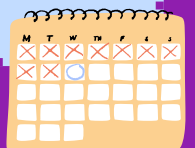

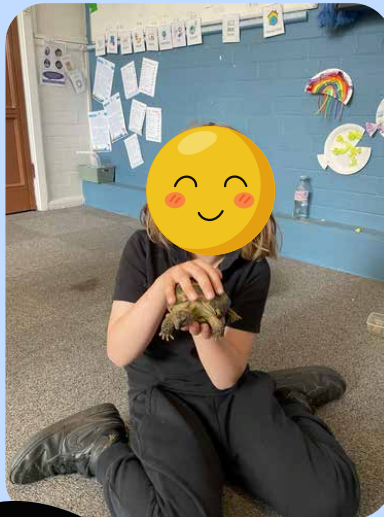
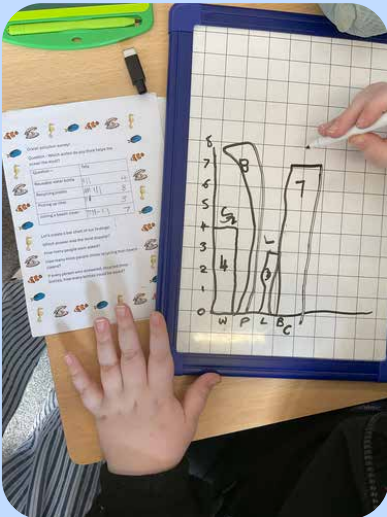


WORLD OCEAN DAY

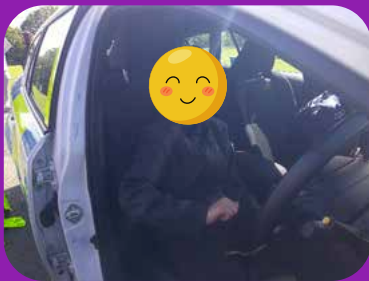

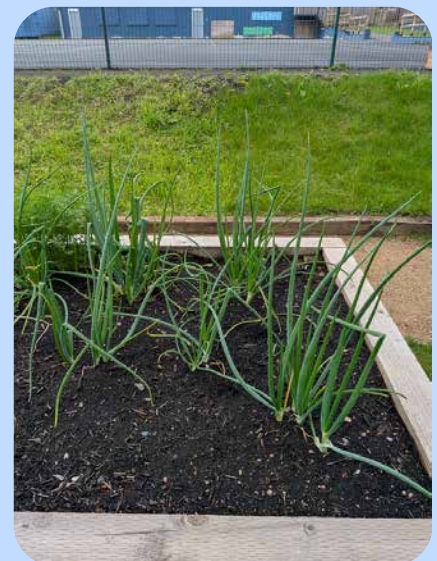
